## I. Introduction

On June 5, 1922, Fallbrook Public Utility District (FPUD) was incorporated to serve water from local area wells along the San Luis Rey River. Since that time, FPUD has continued to grow, and today constructs, operates and maintains facilities to supply water and sewer services to the town of Fallbrook and water and reclaimed water to the surrounding residential and agricultural areas. The District delivers potable water to some 35,000 people over a 28,000 square acre service area.

## II. Scope of Required Services

Paving shall be done according to the County of San Diego Standard Specifications, to include sealed edges where new AC joins old AC, including berms. All AC resurfacing shall be seal coated with an emulsified asphalt and covered with sand. Chip sealing shall be applied as required. All jobsites must have grind header of 12" width and 1-1/2" depth. Contractor shall provide traffic control as required by San Diego Regional Standard. Temporary cold mix asphalt shall be removed and disposed of by contractor. Any additional questions can be directed to the specified project manager listed for each site.

- Area 1 – Daily Road, 40 feet east of Ross Road. 25 feet x 9 feet x 4" depth.

- Area 2 – South Mercedes Road in the Cul-De-Sac – pie shaped. 905 square feet – 6" depth. Remove asphalt from designated areas (marked with white paint), haul away and

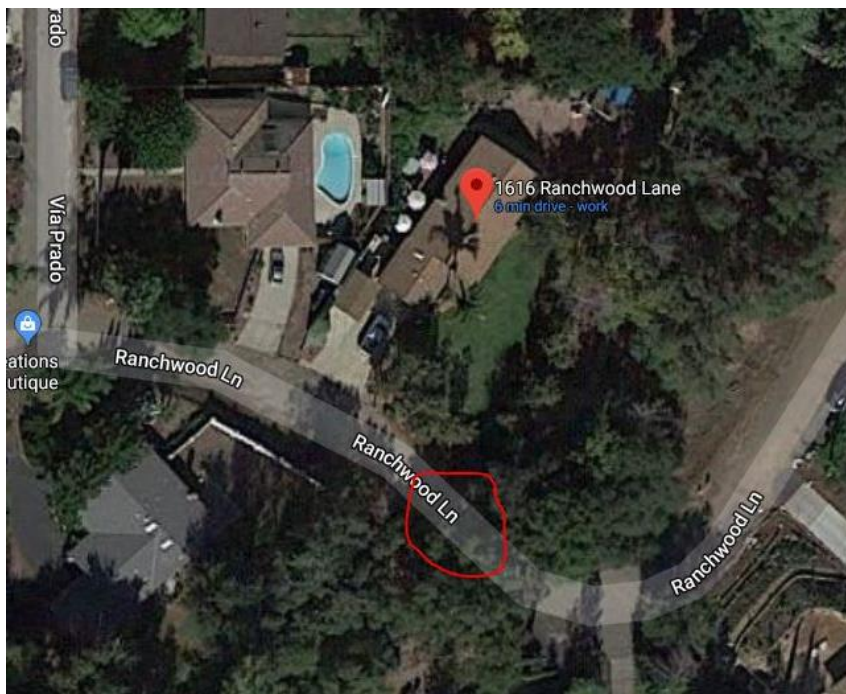
dispose of materials. Refer to Scope of Required Services above for installation of new asphalt.

- Area 3 – 1616 Ranchwood Lane. 26 feet x 18 feet x 4” depth.

### **III. Contractor Requirements**

Any potential bidder shall meet the following criteria:

- Contractor shall provide proof of the following insurance:
  - Commercial General Liability  
\$1,000,000 per occurrence/\$2,000,000 aggregate for bodily injury, personal injury and property damage
  - Automobile Liability  
\$1,000,000 per occurrence for bodily injury and property damage
  - Workers' Compensation  
Statutory
  - Employer's Liability  
\$1,000,000 per occurrence
- Contractor shall maintain and provide proof of a current, valid C-12 state of California license for Earthwork and Paving.
- Contractor shall be registered with the state DIR; this job will be entered into the PWC-100 system. Contractor must keep all wage records as this is prevailing wage work.
- Contractor shall provide performance and payment bonds before notice to proceed is issued.

### **IV. Schedule for Selection and Award**

The selection and awarding of the contract will be according to the following schedule:

3. Final selection and notification .....2/25/2020

Contract shall be awarded to lowest responsive and responsible bidder.
