

Redistricting Process February 2022

What is Redistricting?

- Required by law every 10 years to adjust the District's electoral divisions
- Based on Federal Census Data
- Division Boundaries are to be based on the following considerations:
 - Substantially Equal Populations in each Division
 - Topography
 - Geography
 - Cohesiveness
 - Contiguity
 - Integrity
 - Compactness
 - Communities of Interest
 - Compliance with Federal Voting Rights Act, including majority-minority division
- Two public hearings required for public comment and final adoption

Analysis and Proposal

- Current electoral divisions were established in 2016 as a result of a settlement
- Converted from at-large to by-subdistrict election system
- Census data shows population has remained balanced within current divisions
 - Total Population = 34,738
 - Division Population Goal = 6,948
 - Acceptable Deviation by Law = 10%



- Largest deviation is between 1 and 3, at 9.64%, which is within the acceptable spread
- Current division boundaries can be maintained
- Division 3 meets criteria for majority minority division
